



Remote Instruction Plan

Objective: In the event of inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances requiring remote instruction, American Dream Charter School will seamlessly transition to remote learning using established tools and platforms.

Tools and Platforms:

- Utilize Zoom for live sessions, virtual classrooms, and interactive discussions.
- Utilize Google Classroom as the primary platform for assignments, resources, and communication.

Pivot to Remote Instruction:

- Notification System: Implement a clear communication system via ParentSquare (email, text alerts, website announcements) to notify students, parents, and staff about the switch to remote learning.
- Clear Instructions: Provide detailed instructions to students and teachers on accessing Zoom sessions and assignments via Google Classroom.

Learning Structure:

- Schedule: Maintain a schedule mirroring regular school hours for live sessions, teacher availability, and assignment deadlines.
- Synchronous & Asynchronous Learning: Balance live sessions (synchronous) with recorded lessons, assignments, and resources (asynchronous) to accommodate diverse learning needs.

Support and Accessibility:

- Technical Assistance: Offer technical support to students, parents, and staff for accessing and navigating remote learning tools.
- Accessibility: Ensure access to resources and accommodations for students with special needs or limited technology access.

Engagement and Assessment:

- Engaging Activities: Encourage interactive lessons, discussions, and collaborative projects to keep students engaged.
- Assessment: Design clear assessment methods and provide timely feedback to students on their progress.

Communication and Collaboration:



- Regular Updates: Maintain consistent communication via ParentSquare, email updates, newsletters, and announcements on the school's website or designated platform.
- Collaboration: Foster student collaboration through group projects and discussions facilitated via Zoom or Google Classroom.

Contingency Planning:

- Contingency Protocols: Develop backup plans in case of technical issues, ensuring continuity of learning.
- Flexibility: Remain flexible to adjust schedules, assignments, or teaching methods based on feedback and evolving situations.
